I further agree that my act of applying dues shall evidence my initial and continuing commitment to abide by the aforesaid mentioned Code of Ethics, Constitutions, Bylaws, Rules and Regulations and duty to arbitrate, all as from time to time amended. - 1. Part of your annual dues structure includes \$40 that will be set aside by the Missouri REALTORS® to be used for issues activity. These monies will fund an "issues reserve fund" and may be used in the discretion of the Association to promote or oppose issues that affect REALTORS®.
- Your annual dues includes a \$35 mandatory assessment by the National Association of REALTORS® of all REALTOR® members to fund a nationwide public awareness campaign that includes TV network and cable ads highlighting the value a REALTOR® brings to a transaction and stressing the importance of using a REALTOR®. PLEASE NOTE THAT THE ENTIRE \$35 PUBLIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGN SPECIAL ASSESSMENT IS DEDUCTIBLE.
- 3. Dues payments are not deductible as charitable contributions for income tax purposes. However, dues payments may be deductible as an ordinary business expense. It is recommended that you contact your personal tax adviser about business deductions.
- 4. Contributions to RPAC are also voluntary and are used for political purpose. You may refuse to contribute without reprisal and the National Association of REALTORS® or any of its state associations or local boards will not favor or disfavor any member because of the amount contributed. 70% of each contribution is used by your state PAC to support state and local political candidates. Until your state PAC reaches its RPAC goal, 30% is sent to National RPAC to support federal candidates and is charged against your limit under 2 USC 441a; after the state PAC reaches its RPAC goal it may elect to retain your entire contribution for use in supporting state and local candidates. We need your help with donations to reach our goal.
- 5. The Budget Reconciliation Act of 1993 contains a provision that eliminates the deductibility of lobbying expenses of corporations and trade associations as a business expense for federal income tax purpose. Therefore, the annual dues paid to local, state and national associations will be non-deductible to the extent of that association's lobbing expenditures on state and federal issues. Since your Board/Association has less than \$2,000 of expenses for lobbying on state and federal issues, the non-deductible portion of your local Board's/Association's dues is zero. Please note the amount of state and national dues which REAL-TORS® are not able to deduct on their federal tax returns as business expenses is shown below.
